JRPP approves Coffs Harbour development

The \$20 million Coffs Central Shopping Centre Extension in Coffs Harbour, NSW has been approved by the independent Northern Joint Regional Planning Panel (JRPP).

The extension includes an 80-room hotel with restaurant, pool, recreation area and parking, as well as a commercial and retail area.

The JRPP Chair, Garry West, said the redevelopment was approved after community consultation, and will provide increased employment and support tourism in the local area.

“This mixed development will create approximately 150 job opportunities during its construction, and the operation of the hotel, commercial and retail spaces will further enhance employment in Coffs Harbour,” Mr West said.

“This will help contribute to the continuing vitality of beautiful Coffs Harbour, which has been recognised as a regional city in the NSW Government’s North Coast Regional Plan.”

The JRPP made changes to the conditions of consent to require an amended plan of works prior to the issue of the Construction Certificate to provide accessible ramps from the pavement level to the upper footpath level for better pedestrian accessibility on Harbour Drive road and Gordon St.

In addition, a parking and vehicle access Plan of Management is to be implemented to help facilitate hotel guest parking and check-in procedures.
